RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the McNary/Hondah Community Board has come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Tribal Council support their efforts to maintain the Post Office in McNary; and

WHEREAS, information has been circulating that the McNary Post Office may be phased out in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council advises the Regional Post Office that the town of McNary may soon have a large population increase due to plans for extensive industrial development for the area; and that the Sunrise Ski Area, as well as the town people of Hondah and McNary, depend upon the McNary Post Office; and

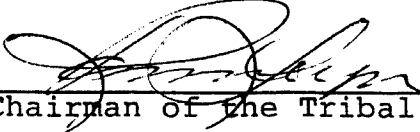
WHEREAS, phasing out the Post Office would create a hardship on the elderly in the town of McNary, as well as an inconvenience for Tribal Enterprises and the proposed paper mill for the townsite of McNary, which may employ as many as 350 persons.

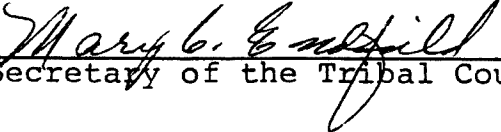
BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the maintenance of the McNary Post Office and recommends that any plans to phase out the McNary Post Office be abandoned as contrary to the best interests of the town of McNary and the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it is hereby directed that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Arizona Congressional Delegation and the United States Regional Post Office of the State of Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on April 15, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution

and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
