RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Mrs. Merintha Jim, a tribal member and a former employee at the Youth Center, has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of herself, Carlena Clarkson and Durango Fall, also former employees of the Youth Center, and advises the Tribal Council that all of them have had at least one year's experience working at the Youth Center, but that when the Youth Center Program was transferred to Social Services, they were terminated and not considered for any positions with Social Services; and that their jobs were advertised and given to others who had not been working at the Youth Center, and


WHEREAS, Mrs. Merintha Jim explains to the Council that they were terminated without any explanation and she and the other woman believe that after a year's experience at the Youth Center, they should have been considered by the Social Services' Department after the Youth Center was transferred to Social Services as part of the contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, after some discussion, the Tribal Council agrees with the former employees that they should have been transferred to the Social Services Department and be allowed to continue with their former job responsibilities at the center.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Social Services Director, Roslyn Mike, to immediately reinstate Merintha Jim, Carlena Clarkson and Durango Fall to their former positions with the Tribal Youth Center.

The foregoing resolution was on April 16, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for 2 Abst. for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
