RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Grace Tessay, a tribal member and senior citizen of the town of Cibecue has requested weatherization assistance to repair her house, specifically, her windows, doors, and locks and to make the home weather proof, and.


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that Mrs. Tessay's request is urgent and she should be assisted immediately.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe that it hereby requests Mr. Billy Kane, Director over the Weatherization Program to direct his department to repair the windows, doors, locks and to weatherize the home of Mrs. Grace Tessay of Cibecue.

The foregoing resolution was on April 16, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and cy-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
