WHEREAS, tribal member, Rudy Walker has requested a homesite in the Seven-Mile area and asks for Tribal Council approval, and


WHEREAS, he explains to the Tribal Council that he has already submitted his request to the Land Board, but was advised that the Land Board deferred Tribal Council to make the decision and grant approval, and


WHEREAS, no opposition has been made to the proposed homesite land assignment for Mr. Walker.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a land assignment for Mr. Rudy Walker in the Seven-Mile area for homesite purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Chairperson of the Land Board to have a survey done of the proposed homesite area and to record the metes and bounds of said homesite with the Land Office.

The foregoing resolution was on April 23, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for 2 abst. 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
