RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Kino Kane, Director of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Detox Center, advises the Tribal Council that April is Alcoholic Awareness month, and that in recognition of the special problems stemming from alcoholic beverages; he recommends to the Tribal Council that Thursday, April 25, 1985 be designated a "NO DRINKING DAY", in which no alcoholic beverages would be sold by the Tribe on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with Mr. Kane that a "NO DRINK DAY", should be observed in special recognition of the problems arising from alcoholism and that Thursday, April 25, 1985 be set aside as a "NO DRINK DAY", whereby the sale of alcoholic beverages would be prohibited.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates Thursday, April 25, 1985, as "NO DRINK DAY", and that the sale of alcoholic beverages on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation shall be prohibited on that day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution should be delivered to the Apache Enterprise and the Tribal Liquor Agent.

The foregoing resolution was on April 23, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 4 for and 2 abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
