RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilwoman Marjorie Grimes has advised the Tribal Council that she would like to have an audit done on the records of the Fair and Rodeo Commission before she assumed responsibility for the records; and

WHEREAS, Marjorie Grimes further requested that the Tribal Council advise her of the responsibilities of the Fair and Rodeo Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has recommended that the Fair and Rodeo Commission meet to review the records and collect information on the commission to decide if it is necessary to have an audit done.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Fair and Rodeo Commission is hereby directed to pursue the activities for the fair and rodeo and make the necessary decisions to coordinate the events of the fair and rodeo.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Marjorie Grimes to hold a meeting of the Fair and Rodeo Commission to review the records of the Commission to determine if it is necessary to have an audit of the records and accounts of the Commission.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 () of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
