

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Mrs. Audrey Altaha, in behalf of her Church Congregation, requested permission from the Tribal Council to have a Tent Revival here in town; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Altaha says that the tent will be located right in the midst of town, yet she feels that although the Revival will be near where the people congregate to drink and party, she feels that it will be in the area where they know they can save a lot of lost souls by turning them away from drinking; and

WHEREAS, the Tent Revival will begin from June 15, 1985 and continue for one month.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Mrs. Audrey Altaha, in behalf of her church congregation, to hold a Tent Revival in the town of Whiteriver, beginning June 15, 1985 and continue for one month.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 3 abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
