RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a delegation consisting of Rencher and Teresa (Johnson) Paxson, Son-in-law and daughter of the late Daisy (Massey) Johnson; Mrs. Audrey (Johnson) Altaha, daughter of Daisy Johnson; Mrs. Geneva (Dayaye) Alchesay, daughter of the late Della (Massey) Gass and niece of Daisy Johnson; Mrs. Agnes (Dayaye) Declay, daughter of Della (Massey) Gass, niece of Daisy Johnson; Mr. Fred Aday, Son-in-law of the late Amos Massey and Mrs. Neva (Massey) Aday, daughter of Amos Massey and niece of Daisy Johnson, who was sister to Amos Massey; Ray Massey, son of Amos Massey, Nephew of Daisy Johnson; and Renzie Massey, son of Hugh Massey, Nephew of Daisy Johnson, came before the Tribal Council contesting the final approval of Farmland Assignment to Mrs. Mayhome (Adley) Goclanney and Mrs. Nettie (Chowbick) Adley; and


WHEREAS, the foregoing list of persons, individually approached the Tribal Council and expressed their knowledge on the history of the land involved, as to its rightful heirs; and


WHEREAS, each person, all relatives of the late Mrs. Daisy (Massey) Johnson complained, argued and demanded that the decision made by the Tribal Council the day before was not judged fairly and without their knowledge and would like the Tribal Council to rescind its action for further hearings; and

WHEREAS, after a very lengthy debate between the above-listed persons and certain members of the Tribal Council, without the presence of Mrs. Mayhome Goclanney and her mother, Nettie Adley, that Resolution No. 85-103 adopted the day before on May 8, 1985, by a vote of 4 for and 1 against and six abstentions, should be rescinded in its entirety and referred to the Land Board Meeting on Monday, May 13, 1985 for a further hearing between all interested parties.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Resolution No. 85-103, adopted on May 8, 1985, in its entirety for a further hearing on Monday, May 13, 1985 in the presence of all interested parties.

The foregoing resolution was on May 9, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for, 1 against and 3 abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
