

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency has arranged for the Tribal Council to interview, in person, several applicants for the Agency Forester Position left vacant by Bud Mast's retirement, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has thoroughly interviewed each and every applicant presented to it by the Superintendent, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to secret ballots cast by the Tribal Council, Mr. David E. Reinhold has been chosen by a vote of eight (8) for and Zero (0) against as the Tribal Council's choice for the position, and


WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency concurs with the Tribal Council's action.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recommends that Mr. David E. Reinhold be appointed as the Fort Apache Indian Agency Forester to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Bud Mast.

The foregoing resolution was on May 21, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
