RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed by Lynn Selander that five students of the John F. Kennedy School have been chosen to attend the CTY Summer Program sponsored by the John Hopkins University Center for Academically Talented Youth; and

WHEREAS, it has been estimated that it will cost \$4,000 for the students to attend the CTY Summer Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been asked to support the request for \$4,000 from the land account to fund the CTY Summer Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the request of funding from the land account in the amount of \$4,000 to cover the expenses for the CTY Summer Program.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby offers its congratulations to the five students from the JFK School who have reached the high academic level required to participate in this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Lynn Selander and Teresa Susan are hereby directed to submit a petition with required signatures to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, to receive funding from the land account for the CTY Summer Program.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
