

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Eleanora John, a tribal member, has come before the Tribal Council and advises that she has a lot assignment south of Whiteriver in an area where construction is being conducted by the Development Enterprise on the HUD Contracts, and

WHEREAS, she advises the Tribal Council that she and her family began construction on a house within a fenced lot assigned to her and that although the house was not completed, it did have a roof and was near completion, and

WHEREAS, she further advises the Tribal Council that persons unknown utilized a bull dozer owned by Development Enterprise which had been left near her home and drove the bull dozer through the fence knocking down her house and substantially destroying it, and

WHEREAS, she complains to the Tribal Council that Development Enterprise should be liable for the destruction of her home as it was their responsibility to lock the machine so that no one could use it for such purposes and; therefore, demands that the Development Enterprise rebuild her home at their expense, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that Mrs. John's request should be granted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Development Enterprise to rebuild the John's home at the earliest time possible at the Enterprise's expense or if the damage is covered by construction liability insurance, that such insurance proceeds be utilized to promptly rebuild the home.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the General Manager of the Development Enterprise to file a report to the Office of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman in respect to compliance with this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 07, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
