RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Human Service Center has come before the Tribal Council with a request for Tribal Council authorization for the Human Service Center to apply for a FY 85/86 funding from the State Public Education Department for the Elderly Nutrition Program, and
- WHEREAS, re-application is necessary in order to receive bonus commodities for the communities of Whiteriver, East Fork, Canyon Day, Cibecue and Carrizo, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that authorization should be give to the Human Service Center to apply for these bonus commodities for the Elderly Nutrition Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Human Service Center to apply for participation in the Food Distribution Program (Commodities) for FY 85/86, for the Elderly Nutrition Program to receive bonus commodities as outlined above.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman to execute any and all documents necessary to apply for and receive these commodities for the Elderly Nutrition Program.

The foregoing resolution was on August 07, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
