

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is a need for a Community Liaison from the Tribal Council to receive complaints and work with the McNary Community in regards to housing problems, sewer and water services, cleanup projects, fire and police protection and a host of other problems that the McNary Community is faced with on a daily basis, and

WHEREAS, Councilman Herbert Tate has offered to act as the Liaison with the McNary Community and to coordinate his activities with Alvino Hawkins and Ray Ivins of the Tribal Safety Department, as well as, with other members of the Council in order to maximize the delivery of Tribal Government Services to the town of McNary, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that appointing Mr. Tate as the Tribal Council Liaison for purposes of addressing the many problems and issues pertaining to the town of McNary would benefit the town and tribe as a whole.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Councilman Herbert Tate as the Tribal Council Liaison to the town of McNary for the purpose of maximizing the delivery of government services to that town as discussed in this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests Mr. Tate to coordinate his liaison activities with Alvino Hawkins and Ray Ivins of the Tribal Safety Department regarding those particular problems dealing with fire, police and other safety matters.

The foregoing resolution was on August 07, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
