

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal members whose children attend the McNary Grade School have requested Tribal Council support for the present principal and administration of the McNary Grade School for the reasons that the administration has an affirmative policy of hiring tribal members as bus drivers, janitors, office workers and teacher Aides, and because the administration has also shown a commitment to the delivery of quality education to Apache children who comprise of 70 to 80 percent of the total enrollment of 90 students, and

WHEREAS, the parents, through their representatives, report that tribal support is necessary for continuing progress at the McNary Grade School and for the preservation of the school, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion of the present philosophy of the school administration and; in particular, that of its principal, concurs with the parents' request that the principal and present administration receive Tribal Council support for their continuing operation and practices.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe that it hereby declares its support for the personnel policies and quality education goals of principal Ray Bills and the majority of the School District Governing Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby supports the continuation of all school operations in McNary for the benefit of Apache children who comprise approximately 70 to 80 percent of the schools enrollment.

The foregoing resolution was on August 07, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
