RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Chief Andrew Kane of the Whiteriver Police Department advises the Tribal Council that there exists a problem with non-member peddlers setting up business in various parts of the reservation which creates a safety hazard to traffic or otherwise, infringes upon the privacy of the community, and
- WHEREAS, Chief Kane recommends that an amendment be drafted to the Peddlers Ordinance requiring the peddlers to set up business in a designated area or an area designated by the Police Department and Tribal Safety Director, and
- WHEREAS, it is suggested that a resolution be passed requesting the Chief of Police and Tribal Safety Director to determine the locations within which peddlers can operate pending formal amendment to the Peddlers Ordinance.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that any and all peddlers wishing to sell goods or services on the reservation as described in the Tribal Peddlers Ordinance are hereby restricted to conduct business in an area to be designated by the Tribal Police Department and Tribal Safety Director until such time as a formal amendment to the Tribal Peddlers Ordinance is enacted by the Tribal Council.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs that a copy of this resolution be delivered to the Acting Tribal Treasurer, Chief of Police and the Tribal Safety Director.

The foregoing resolution was on August 07, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
