## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Dr. Fred Obley has come before the Tribal Council with a request that he be granted leasehold rights to a section of land 75' x 700' within the 12.22 acres deeded by Southwest Forest Industries to the Tribe in 1981, and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Obley is advised that the Tribal Council is unwilling to commit itself to a long-term lease because of the quickly changing economic conditions surrounding the particular strip of land in question, and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Obley is agreeable to a month-to-month lease with a thirty-day termination notice at the prior offer rate proposal of \$1500.00 per year, and
- WHEREAS, after some discussion, the Tribal Council refers the matter to the Tribal Attorney to draft the details of such an agreement with Dr. Obley contingent upon the further approval of the Tribal Council as to those terms and conditions.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney to meet with Dr. Obley and draft an agreement setting forth the terms and conditions of a month-to-month lease for parking lot purposes subject to final approval of the agreement by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on August 07, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
