

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Roger Lupe, Sr., former Chairman for the Fair and Rodeo Commission has come before the Tribal Council and has requested that he be reinstated to his former position as a Rodeo Chairman for the Fair and Rodeo Commission, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lupe explains to the Council that on August 23, 1985, at a meeting of the Fair and Rodeo Commission, the Commission voted to remove him from his position as Rodeo Chairman, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lupe advises the Council that he was removed from his position without justification, unfairly and that the Commission has injured his good name, and

WHEREAS, after a discussion amongst the Council, members of the Rodeo Commission, the Rodeo Commission Chairperson and others, the Tribal Council, concludes that it is in the best interest of the Tribal Fair and Rodeo to let the Commission's decision stand until after the Tribal Fair and Rodeo, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further concludes that any changes in the membership of the Fair and Rodeo Commission should also be postponed until after the Tribal Fair and Rodeo.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that after a lengthy, thorough debate amongst the various parties, it hereby concludes and holds that the decision of the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission to remove Roger Lupe, Sr. from his position as Rodeo Chairman shall stand.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the membership of the Fair and Rodeo Commission shall remain unchanged by the Council until after the Tribal Fair and Rodeo.

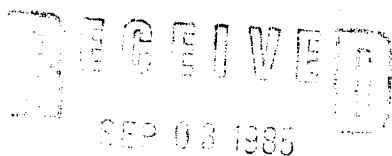
The foregoing resolution was on August 27, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for 1 abstention, 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
