

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has revised their Right-of-Way requirements for Route No. 45, Stago Bridge and approaches, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant gratuitous Right-of-Ways; 80 feet in width, a distance of .603 miles for the road and bridge; 25 feet in width, a distance of .207 miles for an adjacent pipeline; and 150 feet in width, a distance of .138 miles, and 200 feet in width, a distance of .049 miles for a river channel above and below the bridge.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants to the Bureau of Indian Affairs a gratuitous Right-of-Way as described herein and recorded on a map on file in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona, to which reference is hereby made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 84-196 which granted the original Right-of-Way, is hereby rescinded to the extent superseded above.

The foregoing resolution was on September 11, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
