RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Ms. Aleta Brooks and her family is in dire need of a decent shelter and requests Tribal Council assistance, and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Zella Danford Yardley voluntarily came before the Tribal Council that her name be removed from the Ram-Earth Housing Project to be placed on the Home Improvement Program which created a vacancy on the Ram-Earth Housing Project list, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Aleta Brooks name be added to the Ram-Earth Housing Project in Cibecue, replacing Zella (Danford) Yardley.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves that Aleta Brooks replace Zella (Danford) Yardley on the Ram-Earth Housing Project in Cibecue.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
