RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, this resolution pertains to a modification of the Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan for FY/86, issued under authority of the Code of Federal Regulations 25, Subchapter H, Section 163 and Bureau of Indian Affairs Manual 53, Supplement 3, Section 6.6, and
- WHEREAS, regulations require concurrence of the Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan by the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to modify the approved FY/86 Budget to include \$60,000.00 to assist selected Tribal members through forestry schools within Arizona.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby concurs with the modified Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan, which now has a new budget total of \$601,443.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Forest Management Deductions collected will be spent on items designated in the FY/86 Budget and Use Plan and in accordance with 25 CFand 53 BIAM.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended eonstitution and By-Laws of the sribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
