

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received complaints from the cowboys working for the I. D. Ranch that they have not been receiving proper amounts of food from the General Manager, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council also received complaints that the General Manager of the I. D. Herd is using a tribal truck and gas to transport his children to and from the I. D. Ranch to Whiteriver, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has also received complaints that the General Manager for the Agricultural Enterprise has been using a tribal vehicle and gas to transport his wife to her job from Whiteriver to Pinetop on a daily basis, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that when the I. D. Ranch General Manager and Agricultural Enterprise General Manager were hired, it was not agreed that they use tribal vehicles and gas for personal use and that said personal use of tribal vehicles and gas is contrary to tribal policy.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the General Manager of the I. D. Ranch not to use the tribal truck or tribal gas for the purpose of transporting his children to school from the I. D. Ranch to Whiteriver.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it also directs that the General Manager of the I. D. Ranch immediately appoint Mr. Sam Cruz as the I. D. Ranch Commissary Officer to ensure that the cowboys receive adequate food for their daily sustenance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the General Manager of the Agricultural Enterprise to immediately cease using a tribal vehicle and tribal gas in order to transport his wife to and from Pinetop or for any other personal family jobs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Mr. Pete Larson, Tribal Business Administrative Manager to carry out this Tribal Council directive.

The foregoing resolution was on November 12, 1985 duly adopted by a vote 1 Abst. of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
