WHEREAS, Tribal member, Lillian (Antonio) Sanchez, widow of Harry Sanchez, has come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Council approve construction of an additional bathroom to the Sanchez home in Canyon Day, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by prior resolution, authorized an additional bathroom in order to assist Mr. Harry Sanchez, now deceased, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that money from the HIP Program is now available to carry out the prior resolution and that the need still exists because of the family situation involved; specifically, that a member of the family is suffering from a severe handicap.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that HIP Housing Director, Ivan Kitcheyan, immediately process the necessary paperwork to commence construction of an additional bathroom for the Sanchez House in Canyon Day.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
