

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved a plan for a tribal governmental complex in an area now occupied by the Bureau of Indian Affairs maintenance yard; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has set aside an industrial park area now occupied by Apache Enterprise tire facility, Development Enterprise and the Fort Apache Timber Company; and

WHEREAS, the industrial park area was set aside for industrial and commercial purposes so as to concentrate industrial enterprises and heavy machinery in an area away from tribal governmental buildings and residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by prior resolution, requested that Superintendent, Russell Bradley, take action to initiate a removal of the BIA Land Operations equipment now in storage at the BIA yard so that the tribe can commence the necessary clean-up and site preparation for the tribal civic building expansion.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms that the purpose of the industrial park area is to concentrate industrial and heavy equipment operations in an area separate and distinct from tribal governmental and residential areas.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests Superintendent Russell Bradley to schedule the removal of the BIA equipment now in the yard behind the executive building to an area to be set aside in the industrial park.

The foregoing resolution was on JANUARY 14, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958,

and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
