

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has by previous resolution, directed the Tribal Attorney to prepare an ordinance for public posting regulating housemovers on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation as a result of certain problems with the removal of houses at Hawley Lake, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has presented a proposal to the Tribal Council for its consideration and review, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the proposed ordinance should be modified to provide that the housemovers should obtain a State housemovers license, that the housemover definition should be restricted to those persons engaged in the commercial practice of housemoving and be restricted to moving houses or buildings off the reservation, and that tribal members should be exempt from the definition of housemover, and

WHEREAS, any bonds required by the ordinance should be made payable to the Treasurer's Office for deposit in the Central Tribal Account.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney to amend the proposed ordinance for the regulation of housemovers in accordance with the modifications set forth above, and that the proposed ordinance be posted for public comment for a period of at least ten (10) days as required by the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the proposed ordinance be posted in the form attached hereto.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
