

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Honorable Kay Lewis, Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court has come before the Tribal Council and presented for Tribal Council approval a revision of a budget for the Juvenile Diversion Program attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and


WHEREAS, Judge Lewis suggests that the consulting fees in the amount of \$4,800.00 be deleted and instead added to the annual salaries for two diversion counselors; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to the modification of the Juvenile Diversion budget as proposed by Judge Lewis.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Juvenile Diversion Program budget as presented by Judge Lewis of the Tribal Juvenile Court, and specifically approves the deletion of \$4,800.00 in consulting fees and a transfer of said monies to the annual salaries of the two diversion counselors to be divided equally between said positions.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
