

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by Resolution No. 85-229, directed the Tribal Attorney to draft an amendment to Ordinance No. 125, known as the Liquor Ordinance, to provide that the sponsors of public modern dances must obey a 1:00 a.m. curfew and be responsible for clean-up of any public area or otherwise be responsible for the costs of clean-up; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 85-229 further directed that Section XI of Ordinance No. 129 be amended to provide that those persons subject to tribal criminal jurisdiction and prosecution may be subject to a criminal penalty of up to 180 days in jail and/or a \$500.00 fine for violation of the Liquor Ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby adopts the attached amendments to the Liquor Ordinance No. 125 and directs the same to be posted for a period of ten (10) days in accordance with the requirements of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby directed to submit the attached amendment to Liquor Ordinance No. 125 to the Secretary of the Interior for publication in the Federal Register.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g and q) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)

PROPOSED  
ORDINANCE OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe regularly assembled on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 1985 that the White Mountain Apache Liquor Ordinance, Ordinance No. 125, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION II  
DEFINITIONS

(bb) Public Modern Dance as used in this Ordinance shall be any public gathering, dance, party, or other social event held for any purpose other than a traditional tribal ceremony.

SECTION X  
ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES

(a) Violations.

24. Public Modern Dances - All public modern dances are hereby imposed with a curfew of 1:00 a.m. It shall be a violation of this Ordinance for any person to sponsor, participate in any public modern dance past the hour of 1:00 a.m.

(a) Any sponsor of a public modern dance shall be responsible for clean-up of the public area. Failure of any sponsor to clean-up any public area where a public modern dance is held shall be a violation of this Ordinance and said said sponsor shall be subject to civil liability for the costs of clean-up.

SECTION XI  
TRIBAL COURT JURISDICTION  
ENFORCEMENT

(f) Criminal Penalties. Any person subject to tribal criminal jurisdiction and prosecution and adjudged to be in violation of this Ordinance may be subject to a criminal penalty of up to 180 days imprisonment and/or a maximum fine of \$500.00.
