WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that recently laid-off workers from the Fort Apache Timber Company wish a meeting with the Tribal Council, and


WHEREAS, scheduling difficulties and other commitments require that the meeting requested for Saturday be rescheduled to Tuesday, January 21, 1986 at 9:00 a.m., and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to said meeting.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to meet with recently laid-off Fort Apache Timber Company workers on Tuesday, January 21, 1986, and with Fort Apache Timber Company Management that date for the purpose of discussing the events leading up to the lay-off, and for the purpose of listening to the concerns of those employees of the Fort Apache Timber Company.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
