

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise has previously entered into a 638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct a survey of Elk habitat, population, and grazing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation

WHEREAS, the Enterprise is requested to apply to renew said contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in order to continue the Elk Study, and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise is requesting Tribal Council authorization to renew said contract, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the contract should be renewed as it benefits the wildlife and heritage of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise to renew the 638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the continuation of the Elk Study on the reservation for Fiscal Years 1986, 1987, and 1988.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman and the Director of the Recreation Enterprise to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract should begin on December 1, 1985 or as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on January 22, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
