


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, Nephi Valandra, the Director of BIA Education for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation has recently retired, thereby creating a vacancy in said position; and
- WHEREAS, said position is of great importance to the White Mountain Apache Tribe as it directly impacts on the educational opportunities for tribal members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, said position will be advertised by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to interview any person nominated or considered to be appointed to said position prior to their appointment, and to approve final appointment of any replacement in said position.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency arrange for prior review by the Agency Education Board and the Tribal Council, the resumes, background and recommendations of all applicants for the position of Director of BIA Education on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests that any person selected to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Nephi Valandra, be subject to final approval of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council and the Agency Board of Education for the BIA educational institutions.

The foregoing resolution was on January 23, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
