

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the ballots of the 1982 Tribal Election have been locked and secured in the offices of Tribal Council Secretary, Mary Endfield, since the 1982 election; and

WHEREAS, the 1986 Tribal Election necessitates the destruction of the 1982 Tribal Election ballots so that the ballot boxes can be used for the 1986 Election; and


WHEREAS, any and all issues arising from the 1982 Tribal Election have been fully resolved and there is no necessity to retain the ballots from that election.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs and authorizes Tribal Council Secretary, Mary Endfield, to deliver the ballot boxes to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the purposes of the destruction by fire of any and all ballots from the 1982 Tribal Election contained in said boxes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs that said ballots be destroyed in their entirety in a manner to insure their complete destruction so that their confidentiality can be

The foregoing resolution was on January 23, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
