

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Thurza Altaha, a tribal member, advises the Tribal Council that she had a verbal contract with Development Enterprise to remodel or construct an addition to her home for approximately \$3,000.00; and

WHEREAS, she explains to the Council that she has paid more than \$3,000.00, but to date, the project is incomplete and the quality of the workmanship and construction is poor in places; and


WHEREAS, she is requesting Tribal Council assistance to resolve her dispute with Development Enterprise because Development Enterprise is attempting to charge her more money contrary to her verbal agreement with past management; namely, Paul Barry and Wayne Banashley.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Dick Hughes, General Manager of Development Enterprise to investigate Mrs. Altaha's complaints and report back to the Tribal Council the results of his investigation and his proposal to resolve the dispute by the next regularly scheduled Tribal Council meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
