

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, members of the American Legion have requested Tribal Council assistance for the construction of wheel chair ramps for disabled veterans at the American Post Hall on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, it is suggested that Federal Revenue Sharing funds be utilized for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with said recommendation, if Federal Revenue Sharing funds are available for said purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the utilization of Federal Revenue Sharing funds for the purpose of constructing wheel chair ramps for disabled veterans at the American Legion Hall on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Federal Regulations guidelines in respect to three public meetings shall be complied with prior to authorizing Revenue funds for this purpose and further that Federal Revenue Sharing regulations shall be consulted in respect to this use.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
