## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation requests permission to construct additional snow fences on the west side of State Route 273, from the vicinity of the existing fences on Route 260, south towards Sunrise Lake; and
- WHEREAS, the fencing is necessary to keep snow from drifting across Highway 273; and
- WHEREAS, the manager of the Sunrise Enterprise endorses this project, the installation of which is scheduled to occur during the summer of 1986.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Arizona Department of Transportation to install the snow fences, in accordance with the drawings and specifications on file in the office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
