

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, District IV Councilmen recommend to the Tribal Council that Woodrow Bonito of Rainbow City; Mrs. Eva (Pinal) Moody of North Fork and Terry and Elva (Thompson) Dale of Canyon Day be chosen on the basis of need as eligible tribal members to receive HIP houses pursuant to the presently funded program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation made by District IV Councilmen.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Woodrow Bonito, Eva (Pinal) Moody and Terry and Elva (Thompson) Dale be placed on the eligibility list to receive HIP Housing assistance under the presently funded program.

The foregoing resolution was on February 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a,i,j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
