


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Tribal Administrative Manager that there are insufficient funds under the designated Line Item for Tribal Council meetings to pay for Tribal Council member attendance for the remainder of the Fiscal Year 85-86; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that sufficient monies may be available in the contingency money account to pay the Tribal Council for meetings for the remainder of the Fiscal Year.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes payment for Tribal Council meetings from the contingency money account for the remainder of Fiscal Year 85-86.

The foregoing resolution was on February 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
