

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Ms. Fern Goklish, an enrolled member of the Tribe, represented before the Tribal Council by family members, has requested that she be placed on the HIP Housing priority list due to her handicap, severely impaired eyesight, and

WHEREAS, after discussion regarding the present list, the Tribal Council concludes that representatives from District IV should meet and review the priority list so as to accommodate Ms. Fern Goklish's request.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Council members, Herbert Tate, Raymond Endfield, Jr. and Ernie Crocker meet as soon as possible to review the priority list for their area so as to accommodate the housing request of Ms. Fern Goklish.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it suggests to the aforementioned Councilmen that they may wish to review Resolution No. 86-53 as it may be effected by the review requested in this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 11, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
