



RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs had a severe cut in Credit and Financing budget for Fiscal Year 1986, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs in Credit and Financing needs \$15,000.00 to pay part of the salary for Credit Officer this fiscal year, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe needs the position to continue operating the Revolving Credit Program, and
- WHEREAS, by resolution passed on February 24, 1986, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Committee approved allocating \$15,000.00 to pay the salary of the Credit Officer, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Revolving Credit Program will transfer \$15,000.00 from the Revolving Credit Fund to Tribal Trust Fund 7226 to cover the salary of the Credit Officer for the remainder of Fiscal Year, 1986.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that expenditure of \$15,000.00 to pay Credit Officer's salary from Trust Account 7226 is hereby authorized.

The foregoing resolution was on March 12, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
