

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Business Manager for the Sunrise Ski Area advises the Tribal Council that funds for a minimum operation at Sunrise including the salaries of key personnel expires on April 30, 1986 and that; consequently, Sunrise Ski Area must shut down on that date unless interim funding is provided on an as-needed basis to ensure security and interim administration for the Ski Area; and


WHEREAS, the Sunrise Business Manager requests that the Tribal Council authorize expenditures for Sunrise for a period of sixty (60) days until such time as a formal summer budget and operating line is established and approved by the Tribal Council for the Ski Area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Business Office to meet the necessary expenses of the Sunrise Ski Area for an interim period of sixty (60) days or until such time as a summer budget and operating line is established and approved by the Tribal Council for the Ski Area, whichever event occurs first.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it advises the Tribal Business Administrative Manager and the Sunrise Business Manager to meet and establish the minimum needs for the Sunrise Ski Area for this sixty (60) day period.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
