

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that tribal member, Sidney Baha, has requested that his father's grave, the late Chief Baha, be identified with a marker or monument in his honor, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, concurs with this request and agrees that available tribal funds in the budget should be used to immediately carry out Mr. Baha's request and that a suitable monument should be erected at the grave site of Chief Baha.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Business Office Manager to appropriate necessary funds for the establishment of a suitable monument at the grave site of Chief Baha.

The foregoing resolution was on April 16, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
