WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is customary that the Tribal Council sponsor a dinner and other related activities and ceremonies after each Tribal Chairman Election, and

WHEREAS, in keeping with that tradition, the Tribal Council hereby appropriates the sum of \$2500.00 for the purchase of beef and other necessary food items in order to carry out this tradition.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appropriates \$2500.00 in order to sponsor the Inauguration Day Ceremonies for the April 2, 1986 Tribal Chairman Election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Business Office to release these funds from the Tribal Contingency Account or any other available tribal source to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 16, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
