WHEREAS, Timothy Ethelbah, a tribal member, has come before the Tribal council with a request for a land assignment to place his mobile home on as soon as possible, and


WHEREAS, Mr. Ethelbah cannot wait for the next regularly-scheduled Council Meeting due to time involved in legal documents that has to be processed with the bank, and

WHEREAS, the land requested is not in conflict with any other tribal members presently.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that permission is hereby granted Timothy Ethelbah for a land assignment in the area that he is to place his mobile home.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be filed with the Land Office and Land Board Committee Office.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
