WHEREAS, Elvis Fall, tribal member request Council approval of a land assignment to place his mobile home on, and


WHEREAS, his request is urgent and needs approval as soon as possible for this emergency need for a shelter.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that since there is no conflict on the land assignment request of Elvis Fall, it hereby approves the request of Elvis Fall for land assignment to place his mobile home on.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be provided to the Tribal Land Office and Land Board Office.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
