
WHEREAS, the co-sponsors have already been selected and are Larry and Patty Tolino. and

WHEREAS, the arrangements and ceremonies will be held on the weekend of June 13, 14, and 15, 1986 at the old Tribal Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Nannie Case and her son, Anthony Case and Carol Rustin; together with Co-sponsors, Larry and Patty Tolino to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Paige Case on the weekend of June 13, 14, and 15, 1986 at the old Tribal Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
