

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Council Secretary, Mary C. Endfield, has advised the Tribal Council that she wishes to retire from her position as Tribal Council Secretary effective April 30, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Endfield has held the position of Tribal Council Secretary and has faithfully performed the duties of said office since 1944; and

WHEREAS, each and every member of the Tribal Council expresses their gratitude and appreciation to Mrs. Endfield for her lifetime of service and devotion to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, its people, its natural resources, and preservation and protection of the same; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of Mrs. Endfield's time honored wisdom and devotion to duty these past 36 years, the Tribal Council wishes to extend its appreciation to Mrs. Endfield.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby acknowledges the wishes of Mrs. Mary C. Endfield, Tribal Council Secretary, to retire on April 30, 1986.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the commencement and terms of retirement pay shall be determined as soon as possible with the Tribal Personnel Director.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in accordance with Mrs. Endfield's retirement, the sum of \$200.00 per month as an honorarium shall be granted and paid to Mrs. Endfield for the remainder of her life.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Mrs. Endfield is to receive a lump sum payment equal to 616 hours of sick leave as of April 30, 1986, and 229 hours of annual leave as of April 30, 1986, to be paid to her at her present rate of pay.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Mrs. Endfield shall remain eligible for tribal life insurance and medical coverage which shall be paid by her at the rate of \$2.21 per pay period or \$57.46 annually and that she shall be eligible to carry said life insurance and medical benefits upon payment of the annual fee for the remainder of her life.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby expresses its utmost appreciation to Mrs. Endfield for her tireless devotion to duty and her loyalty to the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe whom she has helped guide for many years through her selfless service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council wishes Mrs. Endfield a joyful and blessed retirement.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
