

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Tribal Member David Malone has requested a land assignment in the Bureau of Indian Affairs compound on land presently being leased by the Bureau of Indian Affairs from the Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Superintendent, Russell Bradley, that the Bureau of Indian Affairs has granted permission to Mr. Malone to use said area as a home site but that the Tribal Council due to possible legal ramifications, concludes that there should be written documentation from the Bureau of Indian Affairs granting permission for Mr. Malone to use that site for homesite purposes; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Malone's request should be tabled pending the receipt of documentation from Superintendent Russell Bradley that the Bureau of Indian Affairs has granted permission for Mr. Malone to use said land as a homesite.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby tables the request of Mr. David Malone for a homesite assignment within the Bureau of Indian Affairs compound on land presently being leased by the Bureau of Indian Affairs from the Tribe, pending receipt of formal documentation from the Superintendent, Russell Bradley, that the Bureau of Indian Affairs has granted permission to Mr. Malone to use said area as a residential lot.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
