WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Land Board has requested Tribal Council approval for a homesite for Tribal Member Luppino Lupe and his wife, Marlene Lupe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Land Board has granted approval for a homesite for a mobile home residence in the North Fork Community; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there are no competing or conflicting requests which would legally obstruct Tribal Council approval

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the land site request made by Luppino Lupe and his wife, Marlene Lupe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby directs the Tribal Land Board to file a formal property description of the homesite with the Tribal Realty Office.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
