

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by prior resolution declared that it would not renew the leases at Hawley Lake for an additional term of years; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman's office has recently received several inquiries from homeowners/lessees requesting an extension of time on their lease which has expired or is due to expire in the near future; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration of said, individual requests, the past history of the Hawley Lake leases and the pending litigation in the U.S. District Court; the Council concludes that it should reaffirm its prior resolution and decision not to renew the leases at Hawley Lake nor grant any extensions of time for expired leases or leases that are soon to expire.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms its prior resolution wherein it declared that it would not grant or consider renewals of the Hawley Lake leases except as otherwise provided in the lease itself regarding the removal of houses being dependent on weather conditions.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 11 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
