

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Member, Dorothy P. Antonio, has come before the Tribal Council and requested Council assistance to represent her before the Housing Authority Director and Commission who have declared her ineligible for a house based upon her income; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Antonio explains to the Tribal Council that she is in dire need of housing and shelter and has already paid the necessary monies to the Housing Authority to move into the home; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Chairman's office should intervene on behalf of Ms. Antonio and specifically request that the Housing Authority Director and Housing Commissioners accept Ms. Antonio's monies and allow her to move into a home under the authority of Indian Housing Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there may be vacancies on the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, and further that the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Ordinance outlines the means by which the Housing Authority Director and Commissioners may be appointed or removed; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests that the Tribal Council Chairman make recommendations to the Tribal Council in respect to the Housing Authority Director and Board of Commissioners.

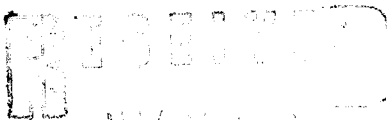
BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to request by letter assistance from the Housing Authority Director and Housing Commission to enable Ms. Dorothy P. Antonio to move-in upon completion of her HUD unit administered by the Indian Housing Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests the Tribal Chairman's recommendations respecting the position of Housing Authority Director and Housing Commissioner positions and to report to the Tribal Council the means of which said officers are appointed and removed.


