

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, Tribal Member, Mervin Skidmore, presently employed by Pinetop Logging, advises the Tribal Council that Tribal Members who are Loggers or Fallers for Pinetop Logging are being cheated and discriminated against by Pinetop Logging; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Skidmore further advises the Council that there is no one to negotiate for tribal members with Pinetop Logging for salaries, wages, bonuses, annual raises, and other conditions of employment; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Skidmore further complains that Pinetop Logging is hiring more Non-Indians than Tribal Members and that they have wrongfully terminated tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, he further explains to the Council that tribal members employed by Pinetop Logging are afraid to voice their complaints because they are afraid of being fired; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Director of the Tribal Employment Rights Office should conduct a full investigation of these allegations and report his findings to the office of the Tribal Chairman in a written report within ten days of the receipt of this resolution and that said report should be also distributed to members of the Tribal Council.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Director of Tribal Employment Rights Office to conduct a full investigation of the allegations made by Mr. Skidmore and to file a written report of his findings within ten days of the receipt of this resolution to the Tribal Chairman with copies to the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
