

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilmember Herbert Tate advises the Tribal Council that there is a need in North Fork community for recreational facilities such as a basketball court for youth and that he is presently requesting bids from contractors who would construct such facilities; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tate further advises the Council that Land Claim Recreational funds are available to finance this construction and that he is seeking approval from the Tribal Council to utilize those funds for the recreational facilities prior to obtaining construction estimates; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tate further explains to the Tribal Council that he is presently discussing the use of said funds with the community people and that he will advise the Office of the Tribal Chairman when the lowest, responsible bid estimate is accepted by the community for the construction of the recreational facilities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby gives its approval for the use of North Fork Community recreational Land Fund monies for the construction of youth recreational facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests Councilmember, Herbert Tate to advise the Office of the Tribal Chairman when the community has accepted a construction bid to construct these youth facilities.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
